On November 4th, 2014, the voters of California passed Prop 47, a law that reduces some felonies to misdemeanors.

Do you have any of the following felonies on your record?

- Simple Drug Possession
- Petty Theft of \$950 or less
- Shoplifting \$950 or less

- Forgery of \$950 or less
- · Writing a Bad Check of \$950 or less
- Receiving Stolen Property \$950 or less

WHAT TO BRING FOR A LIVESCAN

- 1. Bring valid government issued ID and RAP sheet (criminal record), if available
- 2. ***Cost (\$10 50), may qualify for Department of Justice fee waiver, assistance provided

RECEIVE THE FOLLOWING LEGAL SERVICES:

- 1. If prepared, with your rap sheet and eligible for Prop 47, assistance will be provided to file your petition
- 2. If you do not have your rap sheet, you can begin the process to request it, live scan (fingerprints)
- 3. If not eligible for Prop 47, receive free legal consultation about criminal record change
